

Dear students, faculty and staff,

The California State University (CSU) system and California Faculty Association (CFA) have each confirmed this evening that they have reached a tentative agreement. Effective immediately, and given the tentative agreement, the CFA has ended its strike.

Students should continue to reach out to and communicate with their faculty members about plans for each of their classes, and should attend all classes, including any classes that individual faculty members previously indicated were canceled.

Earlier, on Jan. 19, the CSU and Teamsters union announced a tentative agreement. With the addition of the CSU-CFA announcements this means that all strike activities led by the CFA and the Teamsters have effectively ended. It is expected that all CFA members will return to work, to include teaching, tomorrow, Tuesday, Jan. 23.

We anticipate additional information tomorrow, and will continue to update the [university's website](#) as more details about the tentative agreement are shared.
