

Dear SDSU students, faculty and staff,

Following negotiations between the California State University system and the California Faculty Association, the union representing faculty members, the union will be conducting four days of strike activities as follows:

- December 4 at Cal Poly Pomona
- December 5 at San Francisco State University
- December 6 at CSU Los Angeles
- December 7 at Sacramento State University

While SDSU is not a confirmed location for a strike, the following is shared to ensure that you are aware of the planned activities within the CSU system.

Our Shared Responsibility

As a reminder: At SDSU, we strongly support the right of union members to engage in protected labor activities. SDSU will remain open, and that includes auxiliary-owned and -managed facilities. Classes will continue, and university spaces and support services will also remain available, to include the university libraries, residential halls and campus dining.

Instruction to Continue, Support Available

Students should attend class as planned, communicate directly with their faculty members and check Canvas and their official SDSU email accounts regularly. Students should not assume that any of their classes will be canceled, as the faculty union has not announced a strike at SDSU. Strike activities should not have any negative impact on the ability of students to complete courses or to graduate on time.

As a reminder, the university has a website with additional information, to include FAQs and specific guidance for our campus community.
