

Dear Students,

The California Faculty Association (CFA), representing professors, lecturers, coaches, librarians, and counselors at the CSU, has called for a strike January 22 through January 26 impacting all 23 California State University campuses. The Teamsters union, which represents skilled trades employees, has also announced a strike at this same time. SDSU will remain open and operational during this time, and will support all our students during any strike activities.

The strike should not interfere with students' ability to complete their spring 2024 courses and graduate on time. Whether faculty choose to participate in the strike one or more days between January 22-26, or continue to hold their classes is an individual faculty decision, so students should check with their instructors about their individual class schedules and assignments. If a class or service is canceled, you are welcome to share that information via an [online form](#) developed by the CSU.

Again, and as noted above, SDSU will be open during any strike activities, to include residence halls, the library, dining and student support services. You should continue to attend classes, attend activities and, if you have a job or internship on campus, continue to participate.

While on campus, you may see picket lines. You are welcome to choose an entrance that does not have a picket line. If asked, please know that you are not obligated to provide a member of a picket line with your name or any other information.
