

Dear SDSU students,

As shared earlier today, the Teamsters union has shared with the California State University system its plans for a 1-day strike across all 23 campuses on Tuesday, November 14. We want you understand what this means for you:

- SDSU will remain open, and that includes auxiliary-owned and managed facilities.
- You may see union members in and around the vicinity of SDSU and SDSU Imperial Valley engaging in strike activity.
- Student instruction and other student services will continue during any strike activities.
- You should continue to attend class. You should also continue to speak with your faculty and advisors normally about courses, end of year activities, and spring courses and other academic plans. As a public institution the university is obligated to continue providing these student services.
- Students who live in the residential communities will continue to be provided all usual services. Locations such as university library locations, dining and student resource centers remain open, and [support services](#) remain available.

As a public institution, SDSU both supports and promotes the freedom of expression for students, faculty, staff, and general community members visiting campus. The Teamsters strike should not interfere with students being able to complete their courses and graduate on time.

There may be picket lines at some campus entrances. You may cross these picket lines to enter campus, or you may choose a different entrance that does not have a picket line. You are not obligated to provide the members of a picket line with any personal information, to include your name, title, classification or your job location.
